**ROAD OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT
PERMIT
INFORMATION TO APPLICANTS**

PURPOSE:

To control the movement of oversized and overweight vehicles on Township of Wainfleet roads and bridges.

PROCEDURE:

Permits will be issued to the person or Company actually undertaking the move. All applications for a permit must be on the approved forms and must be completed in **all** respects. Payment of fees are in accordance with the township fees by-law and will be billed accordingly. Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.

Permits will be required when any of the following dimensions or weights is exceeded:

Width: 8'6" / 2.62

Length: 75'-6" / 23.00

Height: 13'-6" / 4.14m

Weight: any loading or axle configuration outside the limits established by the Highway Traffic Act Chapter 1-1.8 RSO 1994 or as may be amended

Duration of Permit

A permit may be issued for a single day trip, for a three-month period or for a one-year period.

Three-month and one year permits will only be issued where load is not subject to change and providing none of the following dimensions or weights are exceeded.

Width: 11'- 6" / 3.00m

Length: 79'-5" / 24.20m

Height: 14'-0" / 4.25m

Weight: any loading or axle configuration outside the limits established by the Highway Traffic Act Chapter 1-1.8 RSO 1994 or as may be amended

Escorts

Escorts are required on any move where the following limits are exceeded:

Width: 9' – 8" / 3.00m

Length: 79'-5" / 24.20m

Height: 14'-0" / 4.25m

Weight: any loading or axle configuration outside the limits established by the Highway Traffic Act Chapter 1-1.8 RSO 1994 or as may be amended

The mover must use his or her own escorts except as noted below. All escort vehicles must be equipped with overhead flashing lights, wide load signs and two-way radio communications. Escorts shall be placed 200m before and 200m behind each unit requiring escorts.

Where a load being moved exceeds the following dimensions or weight, the mover must obtain and pay for escort from the policing authority having jurisdiction:

Width: 11' – 6" / 3.5 m

Length: 100'- 0" / 30.50m

Height: 14'-0" / 4.25m

Weight: any loading or axle configuration outside the limits established by the Highway Traffic Act Chapter H.8 RSO 1994 or as may be amended.

Night Moves

Requests to undertake moves during non-daylight hours may be permitted. Each such request will be assessed on its own merits and may be approved at the discretion of the Township of Wainfleet Public Works Department.

Overhead Utilities

It is the responsibility of the applicant to notify all utility companies potentially affected by the move and obtain their consent to move. Any conditions or additional costs imposed by the utility company are the responsibility of the applicant.

Restricted Loading Periods

Overweight loads will not be permitted during the half load period usually extending from March 1st to April 30 of each year.

Conditions of Permits

The issuance of a permit is subject to the conditions set by the Township of Wainfleet Public Works Department.

Permit Applications

Applications may be obtained from the Public Works Operations Centre, 31940 Highway #3 Wainfleet Ontario. Completed applications may be submitted in person, by fax or mail. Permits will not be issued until the applicable fee has been paid.

COMMENTS AND APPROVAL CONDITIONS:

NOTICE TO APPLICANTS:

1. This permit is not valid:
 - a. On highways or Regional roads
 - b. On roads or structures otherwise restricted by Municipal By-Law.
 - c. On roadways with a posted speed limit of 60 km or less between the hours: 0730 to 0900, 1530 to 1800.

2. The use of any road or structure may be restricted by the Town at any time, without prior notice.

3. A current certificate of liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 minimum naming the Town as an additional named insured must accompany this application.

4. Notwithstanding the issuance of this permit, and where applicable, the Public Commercial Vehicle Act and the Motor Vehicle Act apply.

5. The original of this permit must be carried in the vehicle and produced upon demand of a police officer or an officer appointed for carrying out the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act.
