

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF WAINFLEET**

BY-LAW NO. 009-2005

Being a By-law regarding the consumption
of alcoholic beverages on municipal lands
and within municipal buildings and
structures of the Township of Wainfleet.

WHEREAS Section 130 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 2001 Ch. 25. provides that every municipality may regulate matters not specifically provided for by the Municipal Act or any other Act for purposes related to the health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Wainfleet deems it necessary to set a policy regarding the consumption of alcoholic beverages on municipally owned lands and within municipally owned buildings and structures:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wainfleet **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** the consumption of alcoholic beverages is hereby restricted on municipally owned lands and within municipally owned buildings and structures except where permitted under this By-law.
2. **THAT** the consumption of alcoholic beverages will only be permitted on municipally owned lands and within municipally owned structures:
 - (a) on a special occasion basis providing that all permit requirements of the Liquor Licence Board and the Liquor Licence Act of Ontario have been satisfied; and
 - (b) provided that alcoholic beverages are served by persons with certification from a recognized Ontario-based server program or training approved by the A.G.C.O..
 - (c) nothing in this bylaw shall permit alcohol to be served with or without the permissions set out in subsections (a) and (b) above during the Marshville Heritage Festival or any other occasions as may be specified by a resolution of Council.

3. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 22nd day of March 2005.
