## Coronavirus Update Regarding Programs & Services

March 13, 2020, 4:15 pm

The Township of Wainfleet is closely monitoring the local, national and worldwide situation as it pertains to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic. The health and well-being of our residents is important to us.

The Township has partially activated its Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) and the Emergency Control Group will continue to meet at least daily to examine this fluid and rapidly evolving situation.

Currently, Niagara Region Public Health indicates that the risk to Niagara residents remains low. There is one reported case in Niagara at this time.

Township facilities will remain open and we will continue to operate our March Break and regular programming as planned. Members of the public are advised to continue to monitor the Township website for any updates in the event that circumstances change, or if we receive other direction or notification from Niagara Region Public Health.

We are taking measures for everyone's protection:

- We will be undertaking enhanced screening at our facilities. Participants displaying visible signs of illness (including but not limited to excessive coughing or sneezing, high temperature, runny nose, etc.) will not be permitted to attend programming in order to protect other attendees and staff.
- Participants who become ill during a program will be requested to leave.
- We will regularly remind attendees to wash their hands and provide facilities for them to do so.
- We will provide hand sanitizer where water and soap are not available.
- Activities will limit personal contact.
- We will clean and disinfect high touch surfaces and equipment throughout the day, and conduct enhanced cleaning of facilities and equipment at the end of each day.

If we receive any updated direction from Niagara Region Public Health, or determine necessary alternative precautionary measures, we will communicate this immediately.
