This review is to ensure that the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their archaeological licence, that archaeological sites have been identified and documented according to the 1993 technical guidelines set by the Ministry and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations ensure the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.*

This report was subjected to a review that focused specifically on concerns for archaeological resources and/or sites in relation to the outcomes and recommendations of the report. This focused review does not alter or affect your obligation as the licensee to ensure that all reports submitted meet the Ministry technical guidelines and terms and conditions of licence.

As the result of our review, this Ministry accepts the above titled report into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports. One archaeological site was identified during the Stage 2 assessment and it is recommended to be considered sufficiently documented. The report also recommends that the demolition excavations of the extant buildings (i.e. ruins) on the property be monitored by a licensed archaeologist. This Ministry concurs with these recommendations.

Given the above, this Ministry is satisfied that concerns for archaeological sites have been met for the area subject to Stage 2 assessment as illustrated on the addendum map "Document #4", dated October 2010, received November 30, 2011.
